


ABOUT THE SHOW

SUMMARY

From Tony winners Terrence McNally, Stephen Flaherty and Lynn Ahrens, creators of such Broadway classics as Ragtime and Once On This Island, this dazzling show transports its audience from the twilight of the Russian Empire to the euphoria of Paris in the 1920s, as a brave young woman sets out to discover the mystery of her past. Pursued by a ruthless Soviet officer determined to silence her, Anya enlists the aid of a dashing con man and a lovable ex-aristocrat. Together, they embark on an epic adventure to help her find home, love and family.

Helmed by Tony Award-winning director Darko Tresnjak, Anastasia made its world premiere at Hartford Stage in Connecticut, completing a sold-out, record-breaking run before transferring to Broadway's Broadhurst Theatre on March 23, 2017. DIRECTOR'S NOTE

As *Chicago* closed last year, Ms. Kolb and I started getting excited about what to do next. I've found over my 10 years of teaching as a Trojan that it helps soothe the sadness of each show's closing to think, "What's next?"

The first show I said out loud to Ms. Kolb was: *Anastasia*. Little did I know that it would mean a year of Russian-themed productions as I had not yet chosen *Fools* until well into that summer. I'd like to take this opportunity to encourage you to donate to Ukraine Relief efforts that are linked in the QR code below. While we can have some escapism into Russian history and culture, it's with very clear eyes that we can recognize the terror they currently cause.

Growing up, I loved the animated movie, *Anastasia*, and I have come to love this musical just as much (even though many friends have been concerned when I explain this musical does not have a bat character). Sorry for the spoiler.

To the students involved in this production, I thank you for your determination and work ethic. We have taken on a large musical, and I am proud of each of you! To the seniors, I will miss you greatly, and I hope that you continue to pursue theatre in your life - whether it be as a performer, a technician, or an audience member for your lifetime.

The journey we watch Anya go on is one of courage and faith. It is one thing to have courage but it is another to have faith in your own intuition, your own abilities, and in who you are meant to be. Students, my hope for you is that you trust your own intuition and believe in yourself, always. And maybe you do a lot of work in your young life to become someone who you think you're meant to be, and I hope you'll have the courage to change course if you find your heart has changed. Don't settle for a life you think is expected of you. Choose joy.
