

SUMMARY

From Award-winning Elton John and Tim Rice comes a pop-opera tale of two starcrossed lovers from feuding nations. Captured princess of Nubia, Aida, falls for Radames, the Egyptian captain of the guard who enslaved her people. Torn between their conflicted loyalties to their countries and to each other, Aida and Radames must decide to follow their hearts or lead their people. With its stirring contemporary music, and its Grammy and Tony Award-winning score, *Aida*'s powerful love story reveals that we have the power to change history, but only when we make brave choices and embrace our destiny.

HISTORY

French Scholar and archaeologist François Auguste Ferdinand Mariette created the original story of *Aida*. 1869, at the request of his government, Mariette outlined a brief plot for an opera based on his Egyptian expeditions and discoveries. The following year, Camille du Locle worked this concept into an opera scenario and proposed it to composer Giuseppe Verdi. When it premiered in December 1871, the opera was met with great acclaim.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Warning: some show spoilers!

As a whole production team composed of the staff, the cast, and the crew, we had lengthy tablework discussions around the context of AIDA. We discussed the plot, the character arcs, how Radames and Aida fall in love, the time period the show takes place in, how slavery is depicted in the production, and the "why" behind our production. We studied how the Broadway production presented costumes and we decided to take a more culturally accurate approach to some of the pieces, while also still feeling the freedom that they did to create extravagant choices in some of the musical numbers (particularly in "Strongest Suit.")

One of the interesting findings we established was related to how the Egyptians planned for the afterlife and how AIDA brings in the idea of reincarnation. In the West, we have what we call "soulmates," but in the East, there is the "red string theory" - the idea that when two people are born who are destined to be together, they each have one end of an invisible red string tied to them. Through life, no matter what, these two people will find each other. We believe that Radames and Aida have these red strings. In the prologue and the epilogue, we see Radames' and Aida's second life, but in our production, we ask, "What if when we meet Radames and Aida on the boat in this musical, it is not their first life together? Perhaps that explains why they are instantly drawn to each other, despite the differences in their circumstances.

With regard to casting, some high school productions have cast white-appearing actors as Egyptians and people of color as Nubians. We decidedly rejected this choice. We are a diverse department and with Egypt and Nubia being neighbors, it would make sense that the people would look similar; therefore, casting was not based on a student's race. The costume pieces, however, are markedly different based on the character's nationality. Egyptian characters of status have that reflected in their pieces, while Nubians who are still in their Nubian clothing reflect the colorful geometric patterns that are found in Nubian artifacts.

As a team, we discussed the depiction of slavery in this musical. We noted that this story takes place in ancient times when slavery looked differently than how we study it with the Transatlantic slave trade. While the ramifications of the Transatlantic slave trade continue to plague our nation with oppression against people of color, there is a modern-day slavery that we also cannot ignore. Today we call it human trafficking and it exists around us all the time. The production team made space to talk about human trafficking and how we can speak out against it.

For us, this is our "why" behind this musical: To bring to the table the discussion of human trafficking hiding in plain sight around us. Furthermore, in the world of the musical, the ascension of Amneris brings the end of fighting between the neighbors Egypt and Nubia.

In our world, may we see the end of fighting in Gaza soon.

Thank you to this amazing cast, crew, and production staff for bringing this story to life. Your dedication and love for this department is evident in all that you do, and building this show together has been such a joy.




