DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Thank you all for joining us for this campy and endearing tragicomedy musical. Many of you may know *Little Shop of Horrors* as the movie version from the 1980s starring Rick Moranis and Steve Martin. Better yet, you may even have your own history with *Little Shop* as it seems to be a popular marker for every theatre enthusiast. For me, it was the first musical I did in high school - about 20 years ago. I had special memories of *Little Shop*, but I never had the desire to direct it. That all changed last school year on a Drama field trip to New York City.

We had been out for a long day when we arrived at our dinner spot, Gayle's Broadway Rose. If you are familiar with that venue, you know how incredibly exciting it can be for a theatre kid where your waiters will break into musical theatre songs - and take requests - and how incredibly loud it can be for any other human or adult. So imagine me, very overstimulated and ready to leave dinner quickly, trying to fight through the urge to be fully annoyed by the sheer volume, when I look over at the other table and I see some of our boys being serenaded by the song, "Suddenly, Seymour" from *Little Shop*. I sat back, a bit ashamed at my own ornery, fuddy-duddy attitude, and I saw the joy. I won't name names, but seeing one of your students tear up from the joy of a musical song can melt your heart; it can even make you consider picking that show as your next musical because you know your kids will love it.

Little Shop is my thank you to these students, all of you, for reminding me that not everything has to be so serious. It's OK to do theatre that is just purely for the fun of it. It's OK to not have a deeper message. It's OK to just love a show because it's ridiculously campy and the music makes you feel happy. With everything else that goes on in our random and unfair world, it's OK to just find joy where you can in the things that you love.

While *Little Shop* is absolutely a fun show to produce, I would be remiss to not mention the darker themes we had to address. We especially took care as a creative team of educators and students to not ignore or gloss over the themes of domestic violence within this piece. For most shows, I will walk students through creating character backstories, but in the case of this show, I encouraged some of our actors who play characters with dark pasts to not dig too deeply. There's not a healthy way - or necessary way - for a student to create a backstory for why someone becomes an abuser or why someone becomes a victim. Creating a background for that, within the context of this play, would not serve the actor, and it would not benefit this story.

The story of *Little Shop of Horrors* is one I've known for many years now, but I never really loved it until this production with these students and coworkers. Thank you to this amazing cast, crew, pit musicians, and production staff for bringing this story to life. Building this show together has been a highlight of my year.
