



DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Thank you for joining us for this retelling of a beloved classic. So many of us remember the first time we entered the world of Narnia and how it sparked a love of reading and imagination. We hope that spark is reignited for you today as we bring the story to the stage.

The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe begins with the four Pevensie siblings escaping the air raids of WWII in London. As they are forced to leave one war, they find they are forced into deciding whether to join another. We are consistently asked throughout our lives to decide what "side" we will be on, and if we will fight for what is right. While perspectives may differ, I believe that good prevails and that most of humanity - Narnian or otherwise - are fighting for good. We hope that you enjoy our interpretation of this story and find bits of meaning for yourselves. "The secret is to keep your eyes and mind open."

There are many interpretations of this story, but we have chosen to highlight the art of puppetry. The style of puppetry we have used is inspired by Asian theatre traditions that have blended with Western theatre over the last few decades. We particularly play on two theories. One is "the double effect" that many of us have - perhaps unknowingly - become accustomed to through shows like *The Lion King*. The second is the design theory of "Principle of Closure," which is used in all areas of theatre, but particularly in contemporary puppetry. As our brains create closure in designs, it gives us the feel-good chemical, dopamine. Thus, the more we use our imagination, the more we fuel ourselves with good feelings.

It is with great love and admiration that I thank this senior class. I have truly enjoyed seeing each of you take ownership of this space and fill the shoes left for each of you. To the juniors and sophomores, I am grateful to see you rising to new heights and taking on new responsibilities while modeling kindness and leadership. Thank you to our brave freshmen who jumped in and tried something new. We are excited to have you in our family.

"This department exists because of the people who came before you, it continues to exist because of you, and it will exist for the people who come after you because of you."

To my student teacher, Ms. Powell, thank you for choosing us. Thank you for the countless (and unpaid) hours you have poured into this department. I have loved seeing you make connections with the students, and I can't wait to see you leading your own program as you enter this noble profession. From this production I hope that you remember that it's OK to do things scared (*Have we made a giant puppet before? No. Did that stop us? Also, no!*) and that sometimes you just have to start and have faith in yourself that you'll figure it out along the way.

Thank you to our amazing Booster Board who have supported our department and given countless hours toward our progress and development as a non-profit. It has been a blessing in my life to have these parents support this program, support all of the students, and to support me as a mother, too. I am so fortunate to have you all.

Garner High is a home like no other. When I feel the support of my coworkers or encounter the happy smiles of our students, I am reminded that this community is a great place to work and to learn. Thank you to my coworkers for supporting this program and thank you to our students for making every day of work feel like a joy.

as Bear






Lev is a senior in their third year of theatre. They are also an FFA officer and violin player. Ironically, Lev has a fear of horses but is excited to perform nonetheless!




